President of the Minnesota International Center



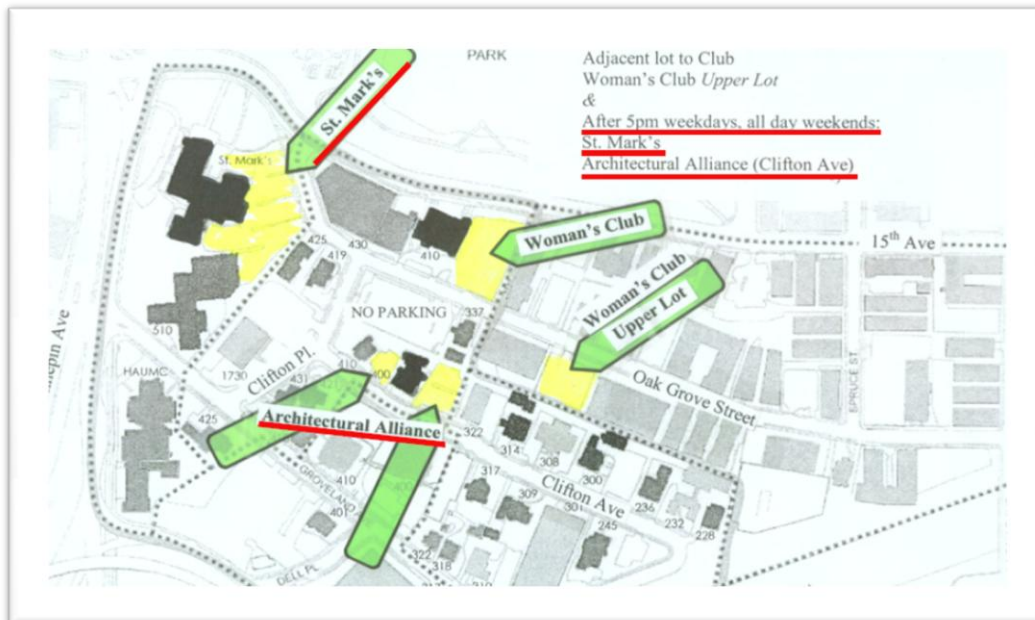
In the 21<sup>st</sup> century, Carol Engebretson Byrne is guiding the Minnesota International Center (MIC) to open global doors for Minnesotans and inspire our community to understand global issues and cultures in an ever changing world. Under Carol's leadership, MIC has evolved to become the sixth largest World Affairs Council in the country, MIC membership has grown from 850 to over 2,000, and MIC revenues have increased 140% to \$1.2 million in 2010-11. In addition to her duties at MIC, Carol serves on the Nobel Peace Prize Executive Steering Committee, the Center for Hmong Studies Advisory Board at Concordia University and the board of the Center for International Business Education and Research at the Carlson School of Business. She was on the national board of directors of the National Council for International Visitors Board until February 2011, the national board of the World Affairs Councils of America from 1998-2004, and served on fact-finding delegations to Brazil, NATO, Northern Ireland and Morocco. In 2003 she traveled to

Oslo, Norway to attend the Nobel Peace Prize Ceremonies. Carol has a Bachelor of Arts degree in International Relations from the University of Minnesota and a Master's degree in International Administration from the School for International Training in Brattleboro, VT. She is a former Humphrey Institute Policy Fellow at the Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs at the University of Minnesota. Carol was also an AFS student in Turkey for a summer when she was in high school. Prior to her tenure at MIC, Carol worked in New York City and Washington, D.C.
